

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Jamestown, as a Tennessee Downtown program participant, will accept applications for facade improvement grants of up to \$2000. Applicants must be located in the designated downtown area which extends from City Hall, west to Vol Street, and from South Main Street Baptist Church, north to Church Street. An application may be submitted for each building or address. Faced improvements may include, but are not limited to, awnings, painting, replacing doors/windows, and some signage. The grant is a reimbursement grant meaning that if an applicant is awarded a grant, they will need to be able to pay for the work, and will then be reimbursed for the amount awarded. No matching funds will be required. Property and business owners are encouraged to participate in this great opportunity to improve your property or business and collectively, our downtown area. A maximum of 10 grants will be awarded. Applications can be picked up at Jamestown City Hall at 314 E. Central Ave., Jamestown, TN 38556. Applications are due at City Hall at 12 noon on Wednesday, November 2, 2016. Late applications will not be accepted.
